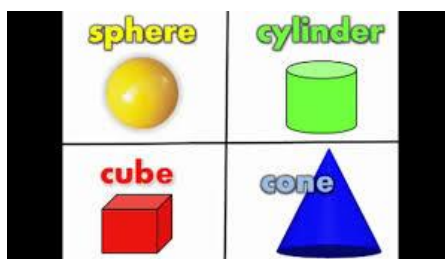
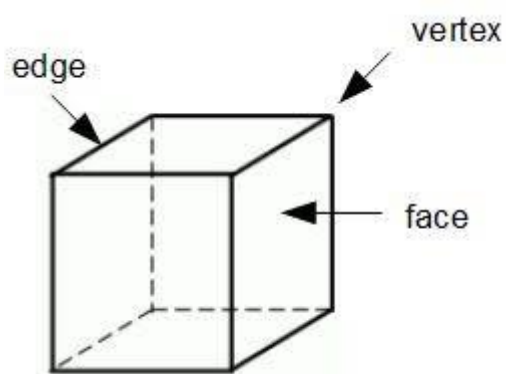

Week 6 - 3D shapes- Monday



This week we will be learning all about 3D shapes. Over the week we are going to learn to name some basic three dimensional shapes and to be able to describe their properties. We will need to use special words to describe these shapes, these are edges, vertices and faces.
