In school we learn two new sounds each week. In our lessons we learn to say the sound, read the sound, write the sound, use the new sound in different words and then we spend time revising the sounds and tricky words we already know.

This week we will keep learning our new 'tricky words' from last week so that we are confident in reading and using them in our writing.

We will also review two are the more challenging sounds the 'o\_e' and the 'a\_e'.

1. Today, have a go at reading each of the sounds below including the 'special friends'. Ask an adult to read one of the sounds aloud and you have to write it in your best handwriting. Can you write all of them? Did you use correct formation for each letter?
