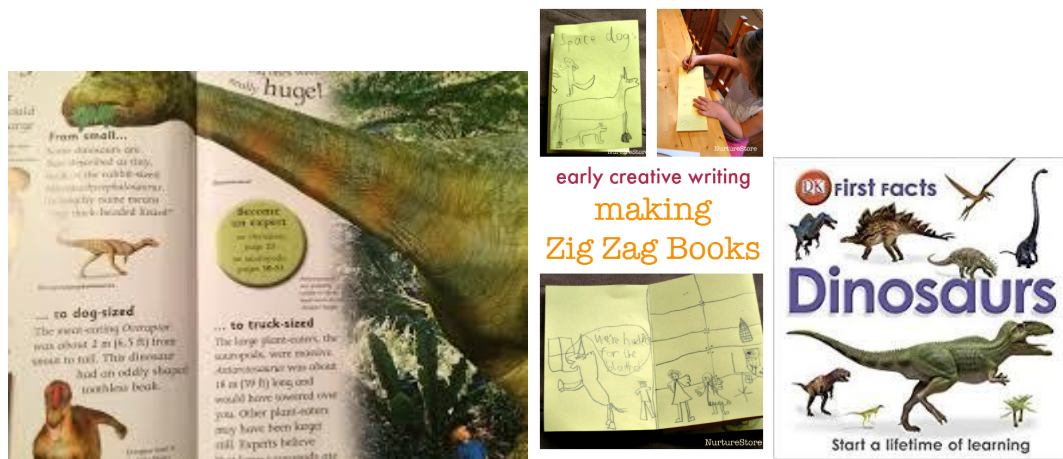


Literacy
Reception Week 7
Information Books



This week your challenge is to make your very own information book about dinosaurs. There are many different ways you can do this and here is just an outline of how you can do this over the week but you can choose how you go about this challenge. The first important part is that you learn to research a topic, for us this week that means to find out new things about dinosaurs. The second important part is that you use all your amazing writing skills to present what you found out in a way that can be read by others- this means you will need to write neatly and use your phonics to help you. You can also copy key words such as the dinosaurs names from the facts that you find out to help you.

Monday:

Use the internet, any information books you might have at home about dinosaurs, the fact cards (saved in this folder) or the facts shared on Edmodo by Miss Ryan to research dinosaurs and learn lots of new facts.

Tuesday:

Choose which dinosaur you would like to write your book about. Make a list of the top 5 facts you want to write about in your information book.

Wednesday:

Make your book- this can be by folding pages. There is a guide to doing this in this folder to help you. If you have any using paper larger than A4 means you have larger

pages to write on and can make this easier. You could also staple together different pages. Begin by writing your title page- remember it will need to have one word or a short phrase to tell everyone what the book is about, for example 'Stegosaurus Facts' or 'My little book of T-Rex facts'.

Thursday (and Friday- remember it is a bank holiday)

Now number your pages and neatly write out for facts from earlier in the week. Make sure you have a picture on each page to make it even more interesting.

Extra challenge:

Can you present your fact book to someone else in your family and read all the facts to them?
