Children, Nursery, Summer Term Week 7, Reading

Repeat the story throughout the week so your child becomes familiar with the key elements of the story.

It is our last week together as a nursery class, so this week we will be focussing on '**Transition**'. At the start of the week we will reflect on our time in nursery and the journey we have made together. Before end the week focussing on the transition/move into the Reception Class.

Below are a list of activities to focus on, I've planned a simple reflective/transition task for each day. But I will post some activities on Edmodo over the course of the week that will assist in our transition theme.

Monday:

- Read/Listen to the story 'Jakes First Day at School'
- Reflect on the story and answer the questions about the story.

Tuesday:

- 'My Favourite Memories from This Year' worksheet. Let's have a look back at our time in Nursery. Who were your friends? , What did you like playing? , What do you remember the most about Nursery? , Is there anything that you are going to miss?

Wednesday:

- 'All About Me Transition Snapshot' worksheet. Let's start thinking about some information we will need to share with the adults in our new class.

Thursday:

- 'All About Me' worksheet. Let's tell the Reception adult's some more details about ourselves.

- 'Make a Wish' Worksheet. Have a good think about what you would like to achieve during your time in the Reception Class. Is there anything you would like to do while in Reception? Maybe something new that you would like to learn?
