### Class Books


Our focus texts for this half term are 'Whatever Next', 'Aliens Love underpants' and 'Pirates Love Underpants'.

### Class Trips

Thank you to all the parents and carers who joined us for our transport and church trips last half term. This half term will be going on an air adventure on the Emirates Airline cable cars in Greenwich.

The letter outlining the details of this trip will be sent out nearer the time.

For this trip we take the London Underground and Overground to Greenwich. Some children do not have experience using the underground. It is a great idea, in preparation for this trip, to take your children on the Underground and teach them how to enter and exit the trains safely.



#### Maths

In numbers we will learn how to independently read and solve addition and subtraction number sentences. Your Child will learn to read and understand the maths symbols +, - and =. They will learn different methods to solve addition and subtraction problems including; counting on or back on a number line, combining groups of objects, and taking away objects.

In shape, space and measure we will be ordering items by capacity and using everyday language to talk about distance and time. They will begin to recognise different o'clock times and sequence familiar events based on these.

Literacy

In reading this half term we will be focusing on reading simple sentences. We will be learning to use words and forms of speech which are influenced by our experiences of different stories. We will also be learning that information can be retrieved from books, such as non-fiction texts, and computers.

In writing we will be practising our letter formation and writing in full sentences using finger spaces. Your children will write a range of words using their knowledge of phonics and will also spell irregular words correctly through their growing knowledge of 'red' words.

You can help at home by making sure your child completes their homework each week, reading with your child each day, and by providing lots of opportunities for them to write in sentences.
