



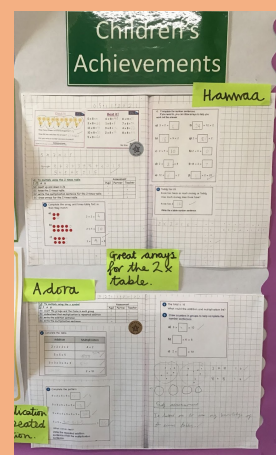
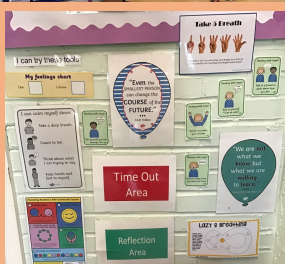
# Check Out What They're Doing In... Year 3!



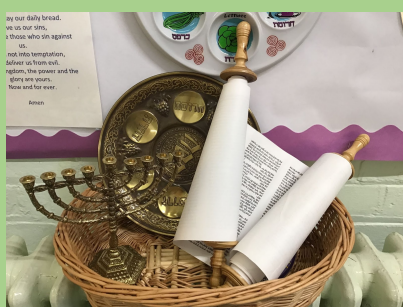
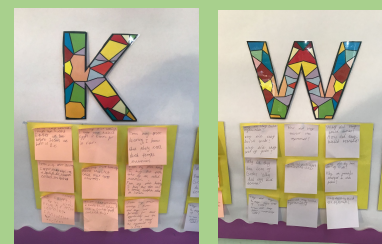
Walking into Year 3 is inspiring! It is clear that children and adults take pride in keeping their classroom always ready for learning.

The range of calming strategies prominently displayed reflects their commitment to developing mindfulness skills as a class.



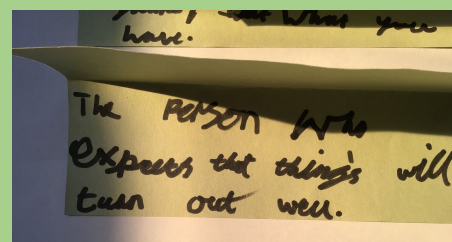
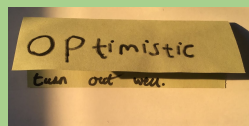
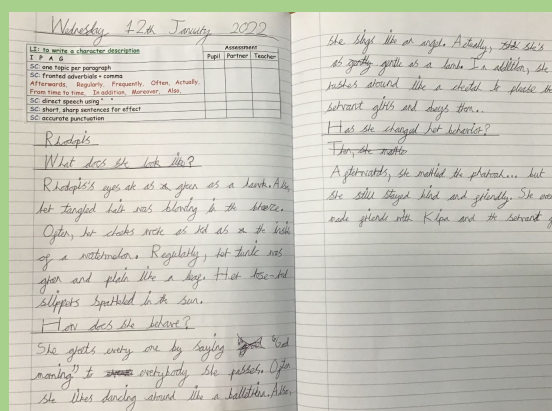
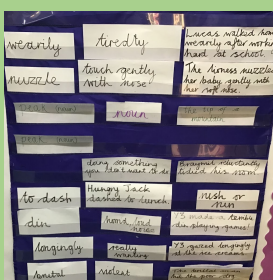
