# Humanities - Geography

This half term we will be learning about Indonesia and Tsunamis as part of our geography lessons.



We will be focusing on geographical skills, as we begin to understand how Tsunamis are formed.

We will then build upon our previous learning, as we



learn how volcanic eruptions and earthquakes can have the potential to generate tsunamis.

### Science

In science we will focus our learning around Light.



In science, our learning will be focused around light and we be thinking about how light travels and how shadows form.

Our key scientist this half term is **Isaac Newton**, who investigated light as part of his key scientific achievements.

# RE and PSHE

In RE lessons, we will be learning about Christmas for Christians.



We will be thinking critically about how the message of Christmas is conveyed by Christians, and how this compares to messages that are spread among media platforms.

In Values, we will be thinking about '<mark>Celebrating Differences</mark>,' as we begin to unpick the concepts of *exclusion* and *inclusion*.

### Home Reading

#### Writing

In writing this half term, we will continue using our class text - The Silver Sword, by Ian Serrailier to inspire us to write newspaper articles and poems about events that



took place across Poland, during World War 2.

For each cycle of writing we will be introducing and developing the following grammar focuses:

- Direct Speech
- Use of colons and semi colons
