Writing

In writing we will be using the book 'Man on the Moon' by Simon Bartram to inspire our writing.



We will:

- Write a formal letter asking Bob questions about his life.
- Write a character and setting description about the moon and an alien.
- Write a persuasive advert for tourists coming to the Moon!

The children will also continue to practise writing sentences using a range of conjunctions to extend their ideas and adjectives to add detail.

There will be a focus on spelling and punctuation, with children learning about how to add suffixes -s, -es, -er and -est and how to use question marks.

Maths

This term we will be focusing on:

- Counting in in 2s, 5s and 10s from different start numbers
- Multiplication and division
- Fractions; learning about halves and quarters of amounts
- Mass and capacity: looking at weighing objects and comparing amounts of liquids.

In our maths lessons the children will be developing their number sense by using concrete resources and representing calculations pictorially. We will be using arrays to help

This half term we will be focusing on the religion of **Islam**.

Our Key question is:

History

Our **Key question** is this term is: What is the role of an Explorer?

We will find out the definition of an explorer. We will then learn about the different explorers and their voyages. The key explores we will be focusing on are:

We will then begin to think about any discoveries or achievements that have made those explorers important.

Science

Our **key question** this term is: What happens in different seasons?
