Humanities — Geography



This term we will be basing our learning in humanities lessons around the exciting topic of

The Amazon Rainforest!

We will be improving our geography skills by answering our key question—What are the effects of deforestation?

At the start of the term, we will conduct field work to identify physical and human features in our local area. This will enable us to make comparisons between Hackney and The Amazon later in the term.

Then we'll focus on the Amazon
Rainforest. We will use maps and atlases
to locate the Amazon Rainforest, using
lines of longitude and latitude to explain
its location. We will then explore the
plants and animals that live there and
interconnected the layers of the
rainforest are.

Writing

Our writing this half term will be inspired by a book closely linked to our geography learning: The Great Kapok Tree by Lynne Cherry

We will begin the term by writing a setting description, using the fantastic illustrations from the texts. Our grammar focus will include using power of threes to create powerful descriptions.



We will also be writing persuasive letters about the impact deforestation has on the biodiversity of The Amazon Rainforest.

PE will continue to take place every Thursday afternoon. This term the focus is Athletics.

Please ensure that your child has the correct school PE uniform for each session.



Oracy

This half term, Year 3 will be debating the statement:

Rainforests are essential for our planet.

The children will use their new knowledge from our geography lessons and persuasive writing task to emphasise their proposition or opposition arguments.

They will practise sharing their arguments using clear and audible voices and focusing on how body language can be used for a confident presentation.

PSHE

Our values focus this half term is Relationships.

We will be learning about the importance of family roles and friendships and how to keep safe online. We will also discuss how our choices affect others around us.



Maths

This half term, we will be focusing on: Money Time Fractions

Year 3 will build on their understanding of fractions from Spring 2 by adding and subtracting unit and non-unit fractions, and findings fractions from a set of objects.

When learning about the value of money, the children will practice adding and subtracting money using real coins, as well as finding change through role play scenarios.

Towards the latter part of the time, Year 3 will learn to tell the time to the nearest minute using analogue and digital clocks.



Please continue to encourage your children to practice their times tables at home. A great

way to do this is on Times Table Rockstars.

In RE we will be focusing on Buddhism.

Our learning this half term will be guided towards answering our key question: What did the Buddha teach his followers about

Throughout this topic we will be learning who Siddhartha was and how he became Buddha. We will explain how Buddhists live their lives in accordance with the teachings of Buddha.
